A guide on how to login and use Ebrary



If you are at college or outside the college you can use the steps below to access most of the E-Resources. The college has access to many e-books through ebrary, which is also known as Ebooks Central where students can access the whole book to read and research information for your assignments!

Apps information:

The two apps below can be downloaded on your device (mobile, laptop, tablet and desktop) to make access easier.

Go to the App Store (iphone) or Play Store (android) or Windows App (Microsoft Store) and download the **Moodle** app and the **Myday** App.



This will give you access to your course, the Learning Resources (library) and other information. Use **vle.westking.ac.uk** as the URL for this app.



Myday will give you access to Moodle, Google Classrooms, Microsoft Teams, college emails, the Learning Resources Centre, where you can access all the e-resources and other useful links.

Step 1. Logging in to Moodle and Ebrary/E-Books Central

There are a number of ways that you can access Moodle.

- 1. Click on this **Moodle** link
- 2. Type in <u>vle.westking.ac.uk</u> in your search box or address bar of your computer or device.
- 3. Use the Moodle or Myday App on your computer or device.

Step 2. Login to Moodle.

The username to login to Moodle is your Person ID/Student number and your normal password to log in to the college computers.


Step 3. Once you are logged in click on the Learning Resources link (highlighted in green)

- **Step 6.** On this screen type in your ID/person number and your password.




Step 7. Search for a book by putting a keyword where you can see 'Search ebooks' and then click on the search button.




Step 8. Search Results – Scroll down to see your search results.


